Phonics and Reading

In the Summer term there will be a greater emphasis on fluency within reading and comprehension skills. We will work on the skills of comprehension as a whole class, while we continue to focus on pace and fluency. It's vital that children are sharing their chosen books at home, whilst practising the skills of reading using their school reading book. Please ensure that if your child has a physical reading book, that it is in school each day.



Writing

In the Summer Term, we are going to be looking at a range of text types linked to our topic of Minibeasts. We will be writing for a range of purposes, encouraging children to build up their stamina so that they can produce a larger quantity of writing. We will continue to develop our understanding of grammar within sentences, and how to apply a variety of punctuation. Please continue to help your child read and spell the words from the Year 1 and 2 word list when working at home.

Maths

We will start the term with a unit of work on measurement, including length, mass capacity and time. If your child has a watch, now is a good time for them to wear it! Alongside this we will have daily practise using the skills of mental maths and calculations, ensuring these basic skills are used frequently so children should have a quick recall when responding to maths questions. We will still enjoy our daily times table rock star sessions and encourage children to join in with our school competitions by logging in at home, to win awards in assembly.

Science – Animals and their Habitats

This term we look at the basic needs of all animals and how the habitat they live in needs to be able to provide everything so the animals can survive. At school we will learn about microhabitats and minibeasts, while on out trip to Twycross we will look at the habitats of larger wild animals living in different parts of the world.

Computing - Making Music and Presenting

Making music involves learning how different instruments can be used to make different sounds on a computer, and how these can be sequenced to create a desired effect.



Presenting explores how to write a create stories, quizzes and fact files including words and pictures.

Art - Art & Design Skills

This unit explores lots of different aspects of Art and Design, including weaving, clay, painting, collage, shading and drawing for fun! Children will learn about specific techniques needed for certaing styles of artwork.

Geography - Mini Mappers

This unit explores the different types of weather patterns, and how these can be recorded. It also explores maps, looking into scale and directions.



Music – Reflect and Rewind

We will be listening to some very famous songs linked to famous people and thinking about how these pieces of music can make us feel.



PE – Monday and Wednesday

Children will have 2 separate lessons during the week. This will include a Kwik Cricket and a Tennis lesson.



PSHE – Changing Me

In this topic we will look at some of the changes that take place as we grow and become more independent. Children will talk about and discuss the different stages in the human life cycle.
