Reception Newsletter – Autumn 1

<u>Welcome</u>

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Welcome to Rabbits class, where your child's school journey begins. During our first week we will be getting to know the children. Once in full time we will make a start on our first topic 'Let's Investigate Autumn'.

Phonics

We will be following a phonics scheme called 'Little Wandle Letters and Sounds'. Phonics will be taught daily alongside this the children will be applying their phonic knowledge to reading matched decodable books.

Literacy

During our literacy sessions we will be encouraging and supporting the children to write their names, while using a correct pencil grip. The children will also be using their early writing skills within the 'Autumn' topic.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths we will be counting, sorting and ordering numbers to 10 and beyond. Gaining an understanding of one more and one less. Developing the skill of 'subitising' which is the ability to look at a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many objects there are without needing to count. We will also explore and talk about both 2D and 3D shapes.

Communication and language

The children will be encouraged to listen carefully to stories and information shared with them. They will be supported to recap on their learning using any new vocabulary.

Personal, social and emotional development

The children will be supported to make positive relationships with both their peers and the adults in Rabbits class. They will develop an understanding of the school rules as well as the class rules. We will encourage the children to become independent.



Physical development

Within both the indoor and outdoor provision the children will have the opportunity to develop both their fine and gross motor skills using the resources and activities on offer to them daily. The children will have a taught session of PE once a week where they will develop their skills such as catching and throwing.



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Understanding the world

Within our 'Autumn' topic the children will learn about the environment what happens as the seasons change. They will get the opportunity to witness this first hand with a walk to the local Kingswood wood.

We will encourage the children to share information about their families and how they celebrate special times in different ways, as well as looking at different countries and cultures.
