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☆ ☆ In this termly newsletter you will find out all about the exciting things we will be learning and any events coming up.

Phonics and Reading

Whole class reading sessions will take place daily, using a variety of texts. We will focus on developing reading fluency, which children can practise at home by reading frequently.

We will also focus on comprehension skills such as inference & retrieval.

Phonics

Writing

This term our writing will be based around the novel 'Beetle boy' M G Leonard by Lindsay Galvin. We will start by learning to organise sentences and paragraphs effectively in an information text and work towards writing an information text and a formal letter. We will then be basing our writing on the book 'Brightstorm' by Vashti Hardy. We will be learning to use authenticating vocabulary to create believable items in fantasy writing and working towards writing a diary entry in an informal register.

Maths

Our first maths unit this term fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be looking at ordering fractions, decimals and percentages as well as working out percentages of an amount.



We will then be focusing on statistics. We will be looking at line graphs, bar charts and pie charts, and learning how to read and interpret these. Following this we will be looking at measurement, including how to convert between metric measures. This term we will also be studying the unit 'shape', where we will focus particularly on measuring and drawing angles. As with every term, we will be practising our arithmetic skills frequently. It would greatly benefit the children if they could practise these skills outside of school too, where possible.

Science

Our Science topic this term is 'Everything Changes'. We will be learning how living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. We will also be learning to recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, and to identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Computing

Our computing topic this term is 'Blogging.' We will start by learning what a blog is and what its key features are. The children will then work collaboratively to plan a blog of their own before writing and publishing it for their classmates. They will then look at and evaluate their own and other's blogs, and discuss their impact.



Design & Technology





In Design & Technology this term, we will create five apparatus designs, applying the design criteria. We will make a range of landscape features using a variety of materials which will enhance their apparatus.

Geography/History

Our Geography topic this term is 'On The Move'. We will first be looking at our needs and wants for the places where we live, as well as what migration is, and the reasons why people may choose to migrate. We will look at voluntary migration and people's movement around the world, and then forced migration, including some case studies on countries where people have recently been forced to migrate.

<u>Music</u>

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Our Music unit this term is 'You've Got A Friend'. We will be listening to a range of songs by Carole King, thinking about the style indicators and the structure of the songs. We will be performing vocal warmups before coming together to perform the songs as a class.



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PE

Our PE units this term will be Indoor Athletics and Multi-skills. In Indoor Athletics we will be practising various skipping, jumping and throwing techniques, and learning how we can hone our skills over time. We will also be competing against others and trying to beat our own PBs. Multi-skills will be a variety of different activities and games to encourage the children to improve on a range of physical skills.

PSHE

Our PSHE topic this term is 'Healthy Me'. We will be looking at the impact that food, drugs and alcohol can have on our body and our physical health. We will also discuss peer pressure, why this might occur and ways to deal with these situations. We will then consider our emotional and mental health, including learning strategies to help with stress and anxiety.

RE

In RE this term, we will be answering the question 'Is Christianity still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on Earth?' We will look at what traits make a good leader and how we could get people to vote for us. We will also consider the 10 commandments and which of them are still relevant today.
